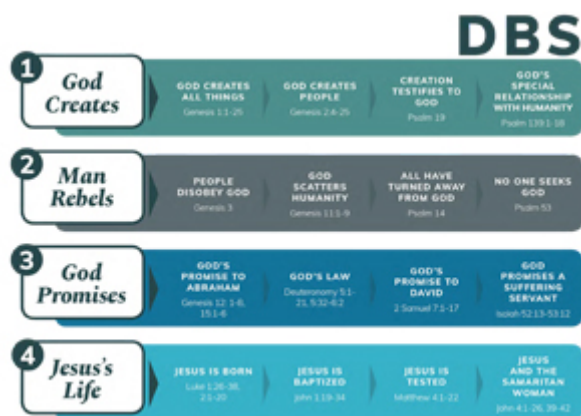


PODS
